**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF THORNDALE ADOPTING  
AN IDENTITY THEFT PREVENTION POLICY**

**WHEREAS**, the Identity Theft Prevention Program is designed to aid in the detection, prevention and mitigation of identity theft in connection with the opening of a Covered Account or an existing Covered Account; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act of 2003, Pub. L. 108-159("Red Flags Rule") requires certain financial institutions and creditors with "covered accounts" to prepare, adopt, and implement an identity theft prevention policy to identify, detect, respond to and mitigate patterns, practices or specific activities which could indicate identity theft; and


**WHEREAS**, to comply with the Red Flags Rule, the City of Thorndale has prepared an identity theft prevention policy;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed the Policy and decided to make no changes thereto.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Thorndale has complied with the requirements of the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act and adopts the Identity Theft Prevention Policy, with no changes, as the Identity Theft Prevention Policy of the City dated June 10, 2009.
