A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THORNDALE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A MILAM COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Thorndale (the "City"), has received a letter requesting the City's consent to the creation of an emergency services district ("District"), proposed to be known as Milam County Emergency Services District No. 1, which includes the City and the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction within Milam County, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to grant its written consent to the creation of the District, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to grant its written consent to the inclusion of its extraterritorial jurisdiction that is within the proposed District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF THORNDALE, TEXAS;

The City gives its written consent to be included in the creation of the District, proposed to be known as Milam County Emergency Services District No. 1, and to the inclusion of the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City that is within the boundaries of the District as more particularly described in Exhibit A. This consent is valid for a period of six months from the date of its adoption.
